FFCF Traineeship Breakdown

- 12 Week Traineeship Programme: The traineeship is completed over a 12 week period. As a trainee you will complete 360 hours with the Fulham Football Club Foundation during those three months.
- Regular football sessions as a player: Part of your weekly timetable will involve participating in CPD (Continuing Professional Development) football sessions. Here you and the other trainees will work exclusively with experienced FFCF coaches in coaching-workshops that mirror how the FA level 1 qualification is delivered. Trainees will get the opportunity to play, coach and assess in these sessions throughout the 12 weeks.
- FA level 1 in Coaching Football: Every successful trainee will be allocated a free place on an FA level 1 in Coaching Football qualification. This will also include your FA Emergency First Aid and Safeguarding Children qualifications.

- 1:1 mentoring: You will be assigned a mentor who you will work closely with to guide and tailor your traineeship. Aside from receiving valuable mentoring for an FFCF coach, each trainee will also be mentored by an FFCF Employability Officer to enhance their employability.
- A variety of different coaching settings: As a trainee you will be provided with a platform to experience the full range of coaching environments the FFCF currently deliver. You will work across a variety of FFCF programmes and an assortment of age groups.
- Entry 3 Employability: You will gain an accredited Entry 3 qualification in Employability to help improve your understanding and application of workbased and employability skills. This flexible course teaches the knowledge, skills and understanding that are relevant, current and useful for both learners and potential employers.
- Free Adidas Fulham FC Training Kit: As a trainee you will be given full Fulham Football Club coaching attire.
- Intensive support to secure future outcomes: Both FFCF and our partner companies will provide you with support in applying for and securing futures outcomes during and after the traineeship programme.

Requirements

One of the following: Current valid passport, Biometric Residence Permit, Photo Driving Licence; Full or Provisional, Birth Certificate or Adoption Certificate; and

Two of the following: Current valid passport, Biometric Residence Permit (UK), Photo Driving Licence; Full or Provisional, Birth Certificate, Adoption Certificate, Bank/Building society statement (issued within the last 3 months) Bank/Building society opening account conformation letter (issued within the last 3 months) or credit card statement (issued within the last 3 months)
